Indonesia is the 5th biggest producer of tobacco. Hiring children under 15 years of age in Indonesia is illegal but around 1.5 million children work in Indonesia's *agriculture. Thousands of them work on rubber, palm oil, and tobacco *plantations.

Many of them suffer from "green tobacco sickness" – they get headaches, get *dizzy and sick. They skip school to help their families make money, but they make only one dollar a day.

Human rights groups are trying to change things. They ask the biggest companies in Indonesia to educate the families about the dangers.

When I was a college student, I had a part-time job working at a hospital. My job was to wheel people from a *ward or the emergency room to the *X-ray department and then take them back again. During the three years that I worked there, I met so many different kinds of people. Each one of them left an impression on me.

One of the most *memorable persons I met there was an elderly woman who I had taken from her room to the X-ray department. In her *chart were the orders *DNR, which stands for ‘do not *resuscitate’. It means that if she were to have a heart attack or *lose consciousness, the doctors were not supposed to do anything to save her.

When we arrived at the X-ray department, she suddenly *grabbed me and said, “Don’t leave me. I know I will die soon, but I don’t want to be alone. Please hold my hand.”

I didn’t know what to say, so I just held her hand and ★ [ア could

When the doctors finally came to get her, she released my hand and thanked me. I told her that I had done nothing except stand there. She responded that it was just what she needed.

I often think back on that moment and realize how much impact we can have on other people’s lives. Sometimes just being there is more powerful than anything we could say.
